The Advanced Camper Program for 12-to-15 year-olds will consist of two parts:

Advanced Camper Orientation/Training: June 30th – July 3rd. This session will include an introduction to the "Camp Putnam Way", an opportunity for Advanced Campers to get to know each other and the staff, as well as many forms of training. Campers will be exposed to Team-building/Trust-building, CPR and First Aid, Crisis Intervention/De-escalation, Creative Gamesmanship, effective leadership techniques and other life-skill programs. This week will provide campers with an intensive course in the skills we believe are necessary to be successful at Camp and in life. There will also be lots of time for creating new friendships or renewing old ones. And, of course there will be tons of Old-Fashioned Camp Putnam fun thrown in!

All Advanced Camper participants who meet the expectations of the staff will be invited back for a full week of Camp later in the summer. This week will combine fun age-appropriate activities with an opportunity to get a taste of what working at Camp is like. Advanced Campers will have the opportunity to help out as "Junior Counselors" with younger campers or as junior members of our kitchen crew, maintenance staff or other areas of Camp. Participating Advanced Campers will return to Camp either August 4th to 8th (run in conjunction with our Day Camp) or August 11th to 16th (run in conjunction with a week for 10 to 12 year-old campers). **Advanced Campers may not choose which week they want to return for; they will be assigned a week by the Camp Director. Decision will be based upon available space and determination of which age group each participant would be best suited to working with.**

Camp Fees and Scholarship Assistance

To determine the camp cost for your child, first you must calculate your Family's Gross Monthly Income. This figure includes **ALL** income for **ALL** family members living with you. After you calculate your income, reference the chart below.

For families with more than one child attending camp, the first child comes at the fee listed for your Gross Monthly Income; all additional children receive a \$20.00 family discount.

****NOTE:** The fee determined below will cover the cost of BOTH sessions. However, poor performance during Orientation/Training may lead to campers being excluded from the second Advanced Camp session. This will be done at the sole discretion of the Camp Director and no refunds, full or partial, will be given.
